## CYBER SECURITY TRAINING – PREPARING FOR ISO 27001 CERTIFICATION

ISO 27001 is a standard that provides requirements for setting up and managing an information security management system (ISMS). The standard helps organisations manage security threats facing critical assets, such as intellectual property, financial systems and data, employee details, customer or client data, and information concerning trusted third parties. It specifies the requirements needed to establish, implement, maintain, and the continued improvement of ISMS within a company's context.

ISO 27001 is often used as a framework to help achieve a higher standard of security within an organisation. Increasingly, ISO 27001 certification may be a requirement by a partnering business in the supply chain used to validate a strong focus on information security.

The course focuses on preparing your team for the ISO 27001 Accreditation process and will ensure they understand:

- Key elements of ISO 27001
- How ISO 27001 is assessed
- How to assess your readiness
- · How to build an implementation plan
